Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 9th January 2024 at 7.30pm in Andreas Parish Hall, Smeale Road, Andreas

1. The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 5th December 2023 having been circulated, were taken as read and approved. Proposed by JF and 2nd by VH were signed by the Chair, JA as a correct record.
2. Matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 5th December 2023.
 - a) The Clerk updated the Board regarding new SLA from Highways. This is currently on hold as the DOI are waiting for some LA's to respond to the 'Final Draft' circulated in September.
 - b) JA has not received any response to date regards quotes for Toilet roof. Deferred
 - c) JA reported that the Chair's Chain of Office is currently being worked on by Corletts jewellers.
3. Correspondence
 - a) Notice received from Ramsey Skips and Northern Scrap Metals regarding changes to Plasterboard disposal which must now be disposed of separately from other materials, as specified by DOI.
 - b) Received from DEFA – notice to inform Local Authorities that the Suspension of DEFA's statutory nuisance investigation service has now ended (Part 1 Public Helath Act 1990).
 - c) Received from CEO of DOI – notice of forthcoming Legislative Consultations regarding i) Consultation on Climate Change (infrastructure Planning) (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Application) Order 2023 by Council of Ministers and ii) Consultation on Marine Infrastructure Regulations by Department of Infrastructure. This was noted by the Board.

- d) Received from Malew Commissioners – invite to Civic Service on Sunday 3rd March
- e) Received from President of Tynwald – request for information from Local Authorities of events taking place during Manx National week 30th June – 7th July.
- f) Received from OFT – notice of extension to closing date for Consultation of Competition Act 2021. This was noted but the Board considered this an area for Central Government.

4. TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING

Ref PA 23/01472/B. 17 Larivane Close, Andreas IM7 4HD. Extension to front of garage and utility.

Andreas Parish Commissioners have considered this application and have no objections to it.

5. New village Play Park

The Clerk asked the Board to confirm specifications for quote for Play Park prior to submitting the details to Manx Lottery Trust to request funding. The estimated spend for this project is approx. £85,000 + VAT.

Letters will also be forwarded to local businesses/trusts to ask for donations.

It was noted that donations for the new play park have already been received from the Bobby Teare Darts match held at the Grosvenor; and from the Andreas Community Christmas Fair.

JF asked if the visuals board for the new Park could be copied for the School. Clerk to arrange.

VH asked if the display could be placed in the pub for everyone to see. Clerk and VH to arrange.

6. Any Other Business

- a) The Clerk reported that the Parish assets need to be revalued before end of March and Chrystals Estate agents will do this for a fee of £500.
- b) The Board reported that there is an excessive amount of dog muck around the village on the paths and walkways. There are 9 dog litter bins placed around the village provided at a cost to the rate payers.
